


Google Scholar recently changed the way BibTex is exported.

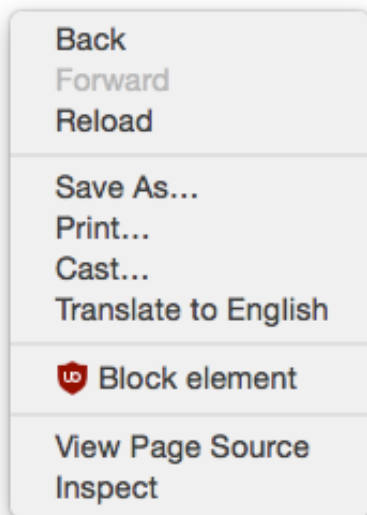
Previously, when BibTex export option was selected, Google scholar downloaded the file in downloads folder for you.

Now, when the “BibTex” export option is selected, Google scholar sends you to a tab within the browser that looks like this:

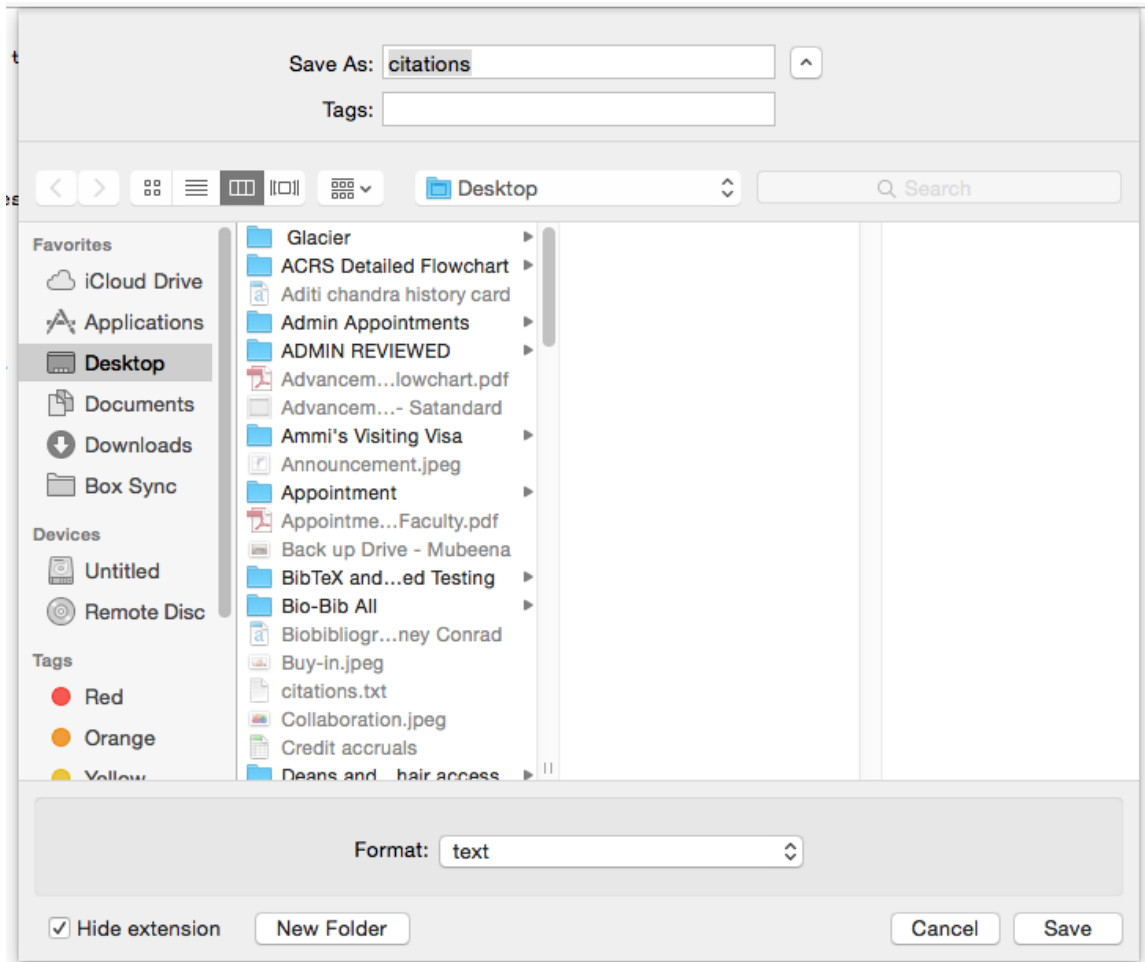

In order to save this as a file to import into Digital Measures, right click anywhere on this page and you will see:



Left click on “save as” and you will see the window below:



Please type in an appropriate file name and save it to the desired folder or just make note of the file location and name.

You may now use this file to import into Digital Measures using “Import Items” feature.
